TRASTOR to support the battle against COVID-19 by financing the upgrade of the Hellenic National Blood Centre facilities

Wanting to actively support the national effort against the Covid-19 pandemic, Trastor REIC shall assume all cost related to the facilities and equipment upgrade of the Hellenic National Blood Centre's (E.KE.A) laboratory. This upgrade shall expand the centre's molecular testing capacity and support the battle against Covid-19.
