## Introduction

This policy concerns the company "TRASTOR REAL ESTATE INVESTMENT COMPANY S.A.", hereinafter referred to as "TRASTOR".

TRASTOR is committed to protecting the personal data collected when you use its website and other services. This policy explains what cookies are, how TRASTOR uses them, and what you can do to manage the use of cookies.

## Use of Cookies

For the website to function properly, we may place small data files called cookies on your device. These allow the website to remember your actions and preferences for a certain period of time, so that you do not have to adjust them each time you visit the website or navigate its pages. We want our website to be useful and as user-friendly as possible, and cookies help us achieve this goal.

These cookies are not strictly necessary for the basic functionality of our website, but are designed to provide you with a personalized browsing experience. However, you can delete or stop accepting these cookies at any time. In this case, you may lose some of the features provided. The information related to cookies is not used to collect personal data, to identify you personally, or for any other reason beyond those mentioned in this policy.

## The Cookies We Use

In this section, TRASTOR informs interested users about the type of cookies used by its website and briefly describes the reasons for collecting them.

**Performance cookies:** These cookies collect statistical information about how visitors use the website, such as the pages they visit most often and whether error messages appear to users. These cookies do not collect information that can identify a user, as they mainly collect aggregate information. They are mainly used to understand how the website works and to improve your navigation.

Here are some examples of how we use performance cookies:

- To collect data about visits to our website, including the number of visitors, the time spent on the website, or where our visitors have been redirected from.
- To compare with other websites, using data collected by trusted analytics companies.

These cookies are usually third-party cookies, which are placed on your device on our behalf by trusted partners (such as Google Analytics). You can read [their Privacy Policy](#) to find out how cookies are used by our partners' services.

## Controlling Cookies

You may choose to stop accepting cookies from your browser or stop accepting cookies from a specific website. However, these options may cause certain services provided by various websites to malfunction if not used correctly.

## About Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored by your browser (for example, Internet Explorer or Safari) on your computer or mobile phone. They allow websites to store information such as user preferences. Cookies essentially act as a "memory" for the website, so that the website can recognize you on your next visit to the website and respond appropriately.

### Websites mainly use cookies to:

- recognize their users,
- "remember" their users' customized preferences,
- help users complete their tasks without having to re-enter information when navigating from one page to another or when revisiting the website

Cookies can also be used for so-called behavioral target advertising on the internet and to display advertisements related to something the user has searched for in the past.

### How are they used?

The web server that provides the website can store a cookie on the user's computer or mobile device. An external web server that manages the files

included or referenced on the website is also able to store cookies. All of these cookies are called "http header cookies." Another way to store cookies is through JavaScript code included or referenced on this website.

Each time the user requests a new web page, the web server can retrieve the values of the cookies it had previously set and return the page with content relevant to those values. Similarly, JavaScript code is able to read a cookie belonging to its domain and perform an appropriate action.

### **What are the different types of cookies?**

Cookies can be classified according to their lifetime and the domain to which they belong. According to their lifetime, cookies are either:

- session cookies, which are deleted when the user closes the browser, or
- persistent cookies, which remain on the user's computer/device for a predetermined period of time.

In terms of the domain they belong to, there are either:

- first-party cookies, which are set by the web server of the visited page and have a shared domain
- third-party cookies, which are stored by a different domain than the domain of the page visited. This can happen when the website references a file, such as JavaScript, located outside its domain.
